Our partners, team, families and friends have enjoyed a thrilling start to the New Year. With 6 wins, 1 place and 2 shows, from 14 starts this year and earnings YTD of \$438,934 it's safe to say we are on the way to another highly successful year in Thoroughbred racing.

Tis the season when all the Derby preps get underway and we all start to catch spring fever. We've had a lot of fun and success at the Gulfstream Park winter meet and look forward to the spring meets at Keeneland, Churchill Downs and Belmont Park.

To update you on some of our horses...

Algorithms: 3 year-old bay colt. Bernardini - Ava Knowsthecode by Cryptoclearance
\$170,000 Keeneland September sale. Earnings \$301,500.

He's a special colt that has done everything right thus far. His brilliant five length win in the Jan 29 G3 \$400,000 Holly Bull Stakes, (while beating last year's Eclipse Award winning Two-Year-Old Champion Hansen) earned him a 105 Beyer Speed Figure, the highest Speed Figure of any three-year old that has run this year. The win, his third in as many starts put him at the top of many turf writers' early Derby Favorites list. Unfortunately, due to a fracture to the splint bone he had surgery today. The surgery was successful and we expect a full recovery and a return to training sometime this summer. We excitedly await a fall racing campaign with this brilliant colt. Todd Pletcher on Algorithms *"I honestly don't know how good he might be because we've never needed to find out more than what we've seen so far — which has been full of run at all stages."*

Thunder Moccasin: 3 year-old bay colt. A.P.Warrior - One Stormy Mama, by Storm Cat
\$95,000 Fasig Tipton July weanling sale. Earnings \$114,300.

Along with Algorithms, we've been blessed to own another very talented colt who under the tutelage of trainer Todd Pletcher is also undefeated in his two starts. He broke his maiden at Gulfstream Park on Christmas Eve and ran back in the G2 \$150,000 Hutcheson Stakes where he won impressively by 6 $\frac{3}{4}$

lengths. The speedy colt is pointed towards the G2 \$150,000 Swale Stakes at Gulfstream Park March 10. Jockey John Velazquez on Thunder Moccasin's performance, *"He runs so hard every step of the way."*

Heavy Breathing: 3 year-old chestnut colt. Giant's Causeway – Takesmybreathaway by Gone West
\$150,000 Keeneland September sale. Earnings: \$24,300.

As if owning two very talented colts is not enough...let us introduce you to Heavy Breathing. He had a very impressive debut February 8 at Gulfstream Park, breaking his maiden by 7 ¾ lengths. He is an exciting prospect and we are looking forward to watching him run in his next start which will be this Saturday (March 3) at Gulfstream Park. He is entered in the third race on the card which is an allowance race for three-year-olds. Heavy Breathing is a half brother to the multiple stakes winner Frost Giant.

Some of our other horses...

Bridge Loan is a three-year-old colt who hasn't broken his maiden yet. He finished third, last time out in a maiden race at Gulfstream Park and will make his next start at Gulfstream in a Maiden Special Weight on the Swale Stakes undercard March 10.

Achaemenes is a four-year-old colt who is a half brother to 2010 Breeders' Cup Classic winner Unrivaled Belle. He has three wins from seven starts. We will keep you posted on when and where he will make his next start.

Holiday Flare is a nice filly we own in partnership with Let's Go Stables. She has two wins, a show and two places from 6 starts. She is expected to run next on March 14 at Aqueduct.

We are very excited about our three promising two-year-old prospects that shipped to Palm Meadows today. They include a Harlan's Holiday colt (Shanghai Bobby), a Dixie Union colt (Rose Junction) and a Street Boss filly (Comare). They will be in training with Todd Pletcher and make their starts sometime this spring.

As is our plan each year, in search of the promising Thoroughbred stars of tomorrow we will be attending the Fasig Tipton July Sale, The Saratoga Select Yearling Sale and Keeneland September Yearling Sale. We will be forming partnerships for purchases at these sales. Partnerships on these three sales will close July 1. If you are interested please feel free to contact us to discuss further.
